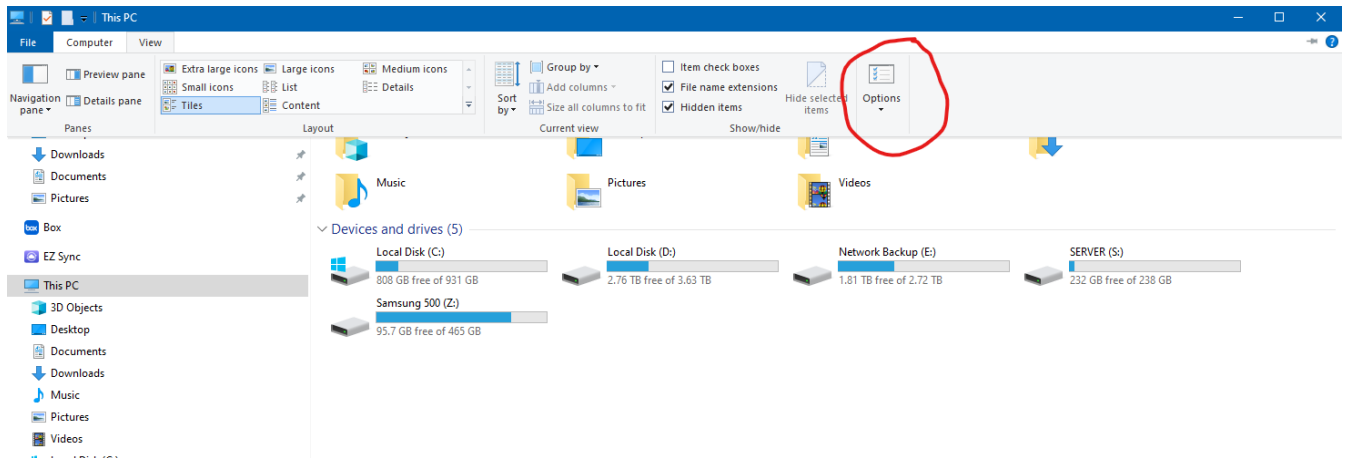
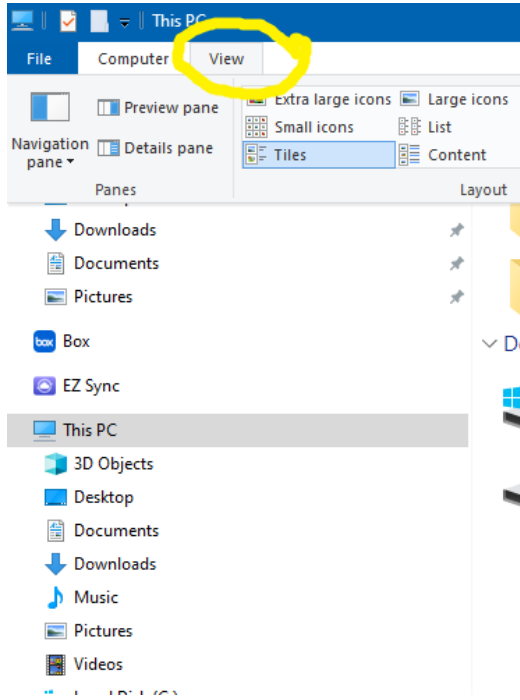
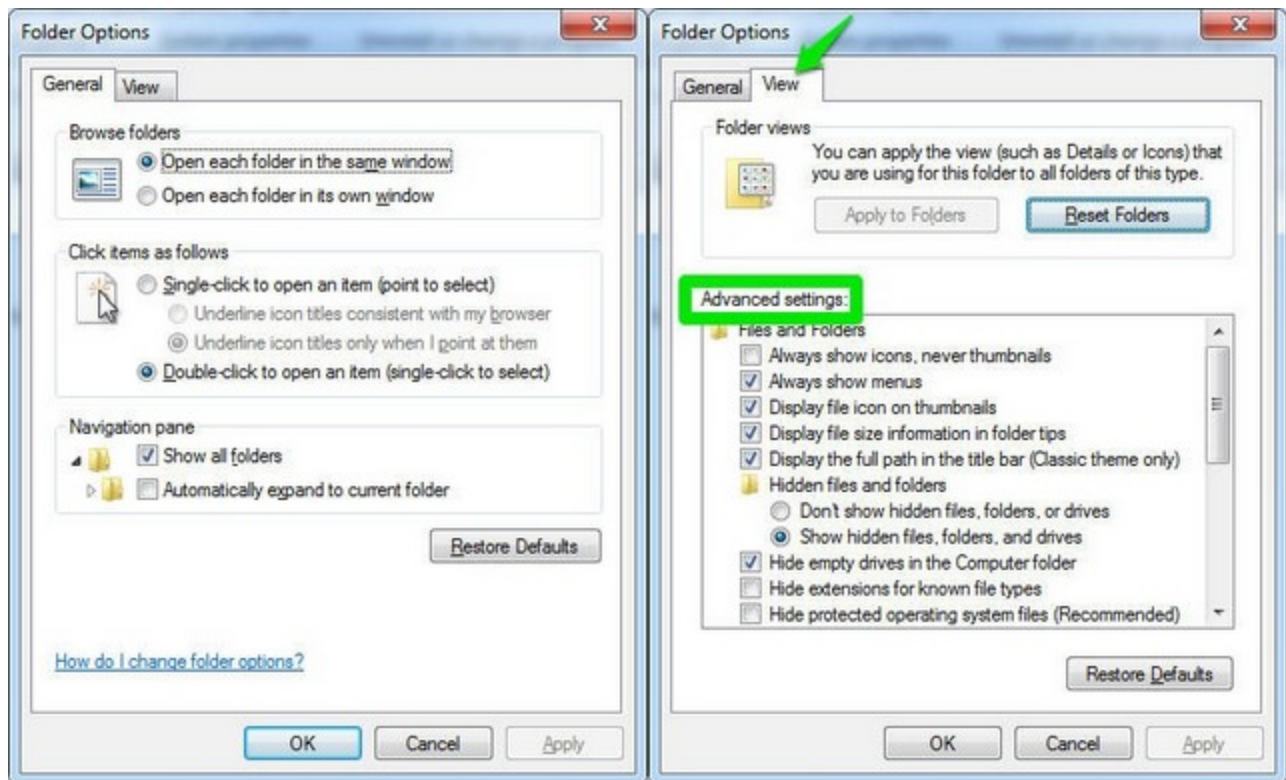


## View Hidden Files

**Advanced settings:**

- Files and Folders
  - Always show icons, never thumbnails
  - Always show menus
  - Display file icon on thumbnails

  - Display the full path in the title bar (Classic theme only)
